Domestic cats are violently sadistic predators and should be subject to the same laws as domestic dogs.

Domestic cat owners should be required to keep their animals confined day and night and/or provide a "cat run" for their pets to ensure protection of local fauna.

There should be no "nuisance" cats roaming the neighbourhood day or night.

If people wish to own a cat, they should be prepared to take full responsibility for the animal's behaviour.

I am tired of lazy cat owners bragging that their pet is "independent".

The damage by feral cats to Australian fauna is immense and directly attributable to lazy and irresponsible cat owners.

The Australian Government needs to take a tough stance on cat owners, and feral cats need to be hunted down and euthanised.
