I write to comment on proposed changes to reduce puppy farming. I fully the support the intent and proposed changes however would like to comment on one aspect of this proposal.

I support the proposal that owners of dogs <u>not de-sexed</u> be required to register as breeders, however I request that this process not be made so expensive or onerous to deter responsible dog owners from being able to have one litter from a loved pet.

Providing the pups are housed responsibly I do urge that the changes not eliminate this experience. Perhaps a temporary licence valid for 9 months or so for one pregnancy could be considered. Were this the case I believe that this proposal impinges on civil liberties, and is not reasonable.
