My thoughts on: Transition pet shops to adoption centres (can only sell dogs sourced from rescues).	Dogs West members are not allowed to sell or consign their dogs to any type of pet shop. The Government should follow Dogs West example and stop dogs of any age being held and sold through pet shops. Pet shops prey on the impulse buyer, they are driven by profit not the welfare of animals. There should always be a cooling off period.
