Matter: Application seeking review of barring notice pursuant to section 115AD of the *Liquor Control Act 1988*

Determination: The application is refused

Reasons: The Commission is satisfied that it is in the public interest to not grant the application seeking review of the decision of the delegate of the Commissioner of Police to prohibit Mr D from entering any licensed premises within Western Australia, except those premises licensed under a liquor store licence for a period of 12 months.

In making its decision, the Commission has relied on confidential police information.

By virtue of the provisions under section 30(3)(b) of the *Liquor Control Act 1988* ("the Act") and in order to preserve the integrity and intent of section 30 of the Act, no further reasons are given.
