Determination:

On 3 October 2013, the respondent issued a notice barring the applicant from entering any licensed premises within Western Australia, except those licensed under a liquor store licence, for a period of 6 months (the "Barring Notice").

On 31 October 2013, Mr P through his counsel applied to the Liquor Commission ("the Commission") for a review of the Barring Notice.

Pursuant to section 115AD(7) of the *Liquor Control Act 1988*, the terms of the barring notice dated 3 October 2013 are varied as follows:

Mr P is prohibited from entering any licensed premises in Western Australia except:

1. those licensed premises under a liquor store licence from the date of this Notice until 2 April 2014; or

- 2. the following premises, solely for the purpose of performing duties related to his work, and provided that he does not there consume alcohol:
 - a) those licensed premises at The Coventry Village, 243-253 Walter Road Morley;
 - b) those licensed premises at the four lots comprising Dolphin Quay, 4 Zephyr Mews, Mandurah; or
 - c) those licensed premises at Sorrento Quay at Hillary's Boat Harbour, 28 Southside Drive, Hillarys.
