


Liquor Commission of Western Australia***(Liquor Control Act 1988)***

- Matter:** Application pursuant to section 25 of the *Liquor Control Act 1988* for review of a decision by the Director of Liquor Licensing to reinstate full entertainment condition upon the licence for the Roebuck Bay Hotel
- Date of Hearing:** 31 October 2011
- Date of Determination:** 31 October 2011

Determination:

- 1 The Director's decision is quashed and the application to reinstate the amended entertainment condition is granted.
- 2 The following additional conditions are imposed on the licence on days when adult entertainment is provided:
 - Crowd controllers, licensed under the *Securities and Related Activities (Control) Act 1996* are to be employed at a ratio of two (2) crowd controllers for the first 100 patrons and one (1) crowd controller for each additional 100 patrons or part thereof from one hour before the commencement of the entertainment until 30 minutes after the entertainment ceases.
 - Strict compliance with conditions set out in CCTV (Closed Circuit Television) Security Systems-Minimum Standards policy of the Director of Liquor Licensing.
