## AMENDED ORDERS -

The Liquor Commission of Western Australia amends the order of determination made on 24 April 2008, by deleting point 2(ii) of the determination -

(ii) Mr Rodgers be disqualified for a period of 12 months from holding a licence, effective at and from midnight on 8 May 2008;

And inserting the following -

- (ii) The operation of the hotel licence 6010011833 be suspended under section 96(1)(d)(ii) until 29 May 2008 or until the licence has been lawfully transferred, whichever comes earlier. Furthermore, failure of the licence being lawfully transferred to another party by 5pm on 29 May 2008, the licence will be cancelled pursuant to section 96(1)(e) of the *Liquor Control Act 1988*.
- (iv) As from 30 May 2008 or from the licence being lawfully transferred, whichever comes first, Mr Rodgers be disqualified pursuant to section 96(1)(f) of the Act for a period of 12 months.

All other orders of the Commission determined on 24 April 2008, remain unchanged.
